about importing medicinal product come into the Kingdom of Thailand.....

การตอบ Dear Sir or Madam.....
Regulations of importing medicinal products to Thailand depend on product
classification.....

- If your products are classified as narcotics or psychotropic substances, you
should get permission before bringing them to Thailand. You can check the list of control
substance at <http://permitfortraveler.fda.moph.go.th/> or contact via narcotic@fda.moph.go.th.....

- If your products are classified as herbal medicines for human use, you should
contact the responsible division via herbaldivision@fda.moph.go.th.....

- If your products are classified as modern medicines for human use, please
follow the instructions below:.....

According to Article 12 of Drug Act B.E. 2510 (1967), a person shall not produce or
sell or import modern medicines into the Kingdom, unless he or she has obtained a licence from
the Thai FDA. Thus, you cannot send the medicine via overseas courier transportation from
foreign countries to Thailand.....

If it is necessary to use medicines, then you can proceed as follows:.....

1. If you travel to Thailand, you can carry medication for self-treatment with the
quantity not exceeding 30 days of usage according to Article 13 (4) of Drug Act B.E. 2510 (1967)
and its amendments. However, please keep the medications in the original packaging with a
valid prescription and/or medical document from the prescribing physician.....

2. If you are NOT a traveler who is carrying personal medicines as stated above,
you can consider this:.....

2.1 You can use any medicines that are registered in Thailand. For checking the
medication's availability, you can search the trade name via Thai FDA website at
https://porta.fda.moph.go.th/FDA_SEARCH_ALL/MAIN/SEARCH_CENTER_MAIN.aspx.....

2.2 In case that your medicines are not available in Thailand, you should consult
the medical doctors in Thai local hospitals for the replacement or substitution to use other
medicines.....
